SIZE

14 cm x 7.5 cm

TOOLS AND MATERIALS

Ricorumi dk Shade 002 (cream) 25 g Shade 004 (pearl grey) 25 g Shade 011 (pink) 25 g Shade 060 (black) 25 g 3.5 mm Ricorumi hook Rico stitch markers Rico tapestry needle Rico synthetic stuffing

TENSION

22 dc and 24 rows = 10 x 10 cm

EAR (MAKE 2)

Rnd 2: 2 dc in each st around. 12 sts.
Rnd 3: [Dc, 2 dc] 6x. 18 sts.
Rnd 4: [Dc in next 5 sts, 2 dc] 3x. 21 sts.
Rnd 5: Ch 1. Turn. Dc in each st around.
SI st into first st of Rnd 5. Fasten off, leaving a long tail and break yarn. Set aside.

Rnd 1: In pearl grey, 6 dc into a magic ring.

HEAD

You will work from the nose to the back of the head.

Rnd 1: In pearl grey, 6 dc into a magic ring.

Rnd 2: [Dc, 2 dc] 3x. 9 sts.

Rnd 3: [Dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc] 3x. 12 sts.

Rnd 4: [Dc in next 3 sts, 2 dc] 3x. 15 sts.

Rnd 5: [Dc in next 4 sts, 2 dc] 3x. 18 sts.

Rnd 6: 18 dc.

Rnd 7: [Dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc] 6x. 24 sts.

Rnd 8: [Dc in next 3 sts, 2 dc] 6x. 30 sts.

Rnd 9: [Dc in next 4 sts, 2 dc] 6x. 36 sts.

Rnd 10: [Dc in next 11 sts, 2 dc] 3x. 39 sts.

Rnds 11-13: 39 dc.

Rnd 14: [Dc in next 11 sts, dc2tog] 3x. 36 sts.

Rnd 15: [Dc in next 4 sts, dc2tog] 6x. 30 sts.

Rnd 16: [Dc in next 3 sts, dc2tog] 6x. 24 sts.

Rnd 17: [Dc in next 2 sts, dc2tog] 6x. 18 sts.

In pink, st a nose by embroidering a triangular shape, starting in the center of the magic ring from Rnd 1 of the head.

In black, embroider two curved eye shapes, with the inside edge at about row 7 and the outside edge at about row 9 of the head. Stuff head.

Rnd 18: [Dc, dc2tog] 6x. 12 sts.

Rnd 19: Dc2tog around until closed. Fasten off, using yarn needle to pull tightly through final stitches to close completely. Break yarn and weave in end.

Attach ears at Rnd 13 of head, about 5 sts apart.

BODY

Body is worked from bottom to top, in an oval

shape.

Rnd 1: In pearl grey, 6 dc into a magic ring.

Rnd 2: 2 dc in each st around. 12 sts.

Rnd 3: [Dc, 2 dc] 6x. 18 sts.

Rnd 4: [Dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc] 6x. 24 sts.

Rnd 5: [Dc in next 7 sts, 2 dc] 3x. 27 sts.

Rnds 6-15: 27 dc.

Rnd 16: [Dc in next 7 sts, dc2tog] 3x.

24 sts.

Rnd 17: [Dc in next 2 sts, dc2tog] 6x.

18 sts.

Rnd 18: [Dc, dc2tog] 6x. 12 sts.

Fasten off and break yarn, leaving long tail for attaching. Stuff body.

Use yarn tail to attach head to body.

ARM (MAKE 2)

Rnd 1: In pearl grey, dc 6 into a magic ring. Rnd 2: [Dc, 2 dc] 3x. 9 sts.

Rnds 3 - 10: Dc in each st around.

Fasten off and break yarn, leaving long tail for attaching. Lightly stuff. Use yarn tails to attach on either side of the head.


BOW

Rnd 1: In pink, ch 25. Dc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Fasten off and break yarn, weaving in ends.

Wrap into a bow. Use an extra piece of yarn to wrap around the middle several times. Secure by attaching near one ear with yarn needle.

ABBREVIATIONS (BRITISH TERMINOLOGY)

ch – chain

SIZE

12.5 cm x 7 cm

TOOLS AND MATERIALS

Ricorumi dk Shade 002 (cream) 25 g Shade 029 (wine red) 25 g 3.5 mm Rico hook Rico stitch markers Rico tapestry needle

TENSION

22 dc and 24 rows = 10 x 10 cm

STOCKING

The stocking is worked beginning with the toe, then the heel, and then up to the top.

Rnd 1: In wine red, 6 dc in a magic ring.

Rnd 2: 2 dc in each st. 12 sts.

Rnd 3: [Dc, 2 dc] 6x around. 18 sts.

Rnd 4: [Dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc] 6x. 24 sts.

Rnd 5: [Dc in next 3 sts, 2 dc] 6x. 30 sts.

Rnds 6-17: Dc in each st around.

Do not fasten off, but leave red yarn attached.

You will pick it back up in round 18.

You will now work the heel of the stocking in turned rows

Rows 1-6: In cream, dc in next 15 sts, ch 1, turn. 15 sts.

Fasten off, and leaving a long tail, break the yarn. Fold the cream portion of the stocking so that the first and last stitch of row 6 match up. Use yarn tail to sew fold together, forming the heel of the stocking. Weave in end.

Rnd 18: Picking up wine red, dc evenly into the ends of the cream rows, with 2 dc in the first row of cream sts, 1 dc in each additional row and in the corner where the rows meet, and 2 dc in the last row of cream sts. Continue to dc in the unworked wine red stitches from round 17. 30 sts. Rnds 19–27: 30 dc.

Rnd 28: In cream, in FLO, dc in each st around. Rnds 29-30: 30 dc.

Ss in the first st of rnd 30. Ch 26, then ss in same first st of the round again. This creates a loop for hanging the stocking. Fasten off, break yarn, and weave in all ends.

ABBREVIATIONS (BRITISH TERMINOLOGY)

ch – chain

dc - double crochet

FLO – front loop only

rnd – round

sl st - slip stitch

st(s) - stitch(es)
