#### SIZE

10 cm

#### TOOLS AND MATERIALS

Ricorumi dk

Shade 054 (ecru) 25 g

Shade 055 (beige) 25 g

Shade 060 (black) small amount for nose

Shade 029 (wine red) small amount for nose

Ricorumi crochet hook 2.5 mm

Rico needle

Rico synthetic stuffing

#### **TENSION**

24 sts and 22 rows = 10 x 10 cm

#### HEAD

Rnd 1: In beige working into magic ring, 6 dc.

Rnd 2: [2 dc in next st] 6 times. 12 sts.

Rnd 3: [1 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times. 18 sts.

Rnd 4: [2 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times. 24 sts.

Rnd 5: [3 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times. 30 sts.

Rnd 6: [4 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times. 36 sts.

Rnd 7: [5 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times. 42 sts.

Rnd 8–17: 42 dc.

Rnd 18: [5 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 36 sts.

Rnd 19: [4 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 30 sts.

Begin to stuff now.

Rnd 20: [3 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 24 sts

Rnd 21: [2 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 18 sts.

Rnd 22: [1 dc, dc2tog] 6 times.12 sts.

Rnd 23: [dc2tog] 6 times. 6 sts.

Finish off. Leave a long tail, weave through the front loops of the last 6 sts and pull tight to close.

#### MUZZLE

Rnd 1: In ecru working into magic ring, 6 dc.

Rnd 2: [2 dc in next st] 6 times. 12 sts.

Rnd 3: [1 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times. 18 sts.

SI st into the next st to finish off, leave a long tail. Embroider nose as seen on the picture in wine red. Sew the muzzle to the head using the long

Embroider the eyes using black.

## Christmas Crochet Along

### "RON THE REINDEER"

#### EAR (MAKE 2)

Start with a magic ring but then ch 1 and turn at

the end of each row.

Row 1: In beige working into magic ring 8 dc.

Pull the ring tight.

Row 2: 8 dc.

Row 3: dc2tog, 4 dc, dc2tog. 6 sts.

Row 4: 6 dc.

Row 5: dc2tog, 2 dc, dc2tog. 4 sts.

Row 6: 4 dc.

Row 7: dc2tog, twice. 2 sts.

Row 8: 2 dc.

Weave in end. Using the tail from the magic ring

sew ear to head.

#### LARGE ANTLER (MAKE 2)

Rnd 1: In beige working into magic ring 7 dc.

Rnd 2 - 10: 7 dc.

Finish off leaving a long tail.

#### **SMALL ANTLER (MAKE 2)**

Rnd 1: In beige working into a magic ring 6 dc.

Rnd 2 - 4: 6 dc.

Finish off leaving a long tail.

Sew one small antler to one large antler, then sew

them to the top of the head.

#### **BODY**

Rnd 1: Using beige working into magic ring, 6 dc.

Rnd 2: [2 dc in next st] 6 times. 12 sts.

Rnd 3: [2 dc in next st] 12 times. 24 sts.

Rnd 4: [3 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times. 30 sts.

Rnd 5: BLO, 30 dc.

Rnd 6 - 8: 30 dc.

Rnd 9: [3 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 24 sts.

Rnd 10-11: 24 dc.

Rnd 12: [2 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 18 sts.

Rnd 13-14: 18 dc.

Rnd 15: [1 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 12 sts.

Rnd 16-17: 12 dc.

Finish off leaving a long tail. Stuff the body then sew the body to the head using the tail.

#### ARM (MAKE 2)

Rnd 1: In beige working into magic ring 6 dc.

Rnd 2 – 9: 6 dc.

Flatten the top of the arm and dc through both sets of sts to close.

Finish off leaving a long tail. Sew arms to the sides of the body right at the top of the neck.

Embroider little sts in ecru as seen on the picture to the head.

# Christmas Crochet Along "CHRISTMAS STOCKING"



#### SIZE

12.5 cm x 7 cm

#### **TOOLS AND MATERIALS**

Ricorumi dk Shade 002 (cream) 25 g Shade 029 (wine red) 25 g 3.5 mm Rico hook Rico stitch markers Rico tapestry needle

#### **TENSION**

22 dc and 24 rows = 10 x 10 cm

#### **STOCKING**

The stocking is worked beginning with the toe, then the heel, and then up to the top.

Rnd 1: In wine red, 6 dc in a magic ring.

Rnd 2: 2 dc in each st. 12 sts.

Rnd 3: [Dc, 2 dc] 6x around. 18 sts.

Rnd 4: [Dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc] 6x. 24 sts.

Rnd 5: [Dc in next 3 sts, 2 dc] 6x. 30 sts.

Rnds 6-17: Dc in each st around.

Do not fasten off, but leave red yarn attached.

You will pick it back up in round 18.

You will now work the heel of the stocking in turned rows

Rows 1-6: In cream, dc in next 15 sts, ch 1, turn. 15 sts.

Fasten off, and leaving a long tail, break the yarn. Fold the cream portion of the stocking so that the first and last stitch of row 6 match up. Use yarn tail to sew fold together, forming the heel of the stocking. Weave in end.

Rnd 18: Picking up wine red, dc evenly into the ends of the cream rows, with 2 dc in the first row of cream sts, 1 dc in each additional row and in the corner where the rows meet, and 2 dc in the last row of cream sts. Continue to dc in the unworked wine red stitches from round 17. 30 sts. Rnds 19–27: 30 dc.

Rnd 28: In cream, in FLO, dc in each st around. Rnds 29-30: 30 dc.

Ss in the first st of rnd 30. Ch 26, then ss in same first st of the round again. This creates a loop for hanging the stocking. Fasten off, break yarn, and weave in all ends.

### ABBREVIATIONS (BRITISH TERMINOLOGY)

ch - chain

dc - double crochet

FLO – front loop only

rnd – round

sl st – slip stitch

st(s) - stitch(es)
