SIZE

14 cm

TOOLS AND MATERIALS

Shade 001 (white) 25 g
Small amounts of the following
Shade 003 (light grey)
Shade 011 (pink)
Shade 032 (blue)
Shade 060 (black)
Ricorumi Lamé dk
Shade 001 (silver)
Rico book 3 mm

TENSION

24 dc and 26 rows = 10x10 cm

2 Ricorumi eye buttons 5 mm Rico synthetic stuffing

HEAD

Using light grey, 2 ch.

Rnd 1: 5 dc in 2nd ch from hook. 5 sts.

Rnd 2: 2 dc in each st around. 10 sts.

Rnd 3: join white, 10 dc.

Rnd 4: (1 dc, 2 dc in next st) 5 times. 15 sts.

Rnd 5: 15 dc.

Rnd 6: (2 dc, 2 dc in next st) 5 times. 20 sts.

Rnd 7: (3 dc, 2 dc in next st) 5 times. 25 sts.

Rnd 8: (4 dc, 2 dc in next st) 5 times. 30 sts.

Rnds 9 to 14: 30 dc.

Rnd 15: (3 dc, dc2tog) 6 times. 24 sts.

Rnd 16: (2 dc, dc2tog) 6 times. 18 sts.

Rnd 17: (1 dc, dc2tog) 6 times. 12 sts.

Stuff head.

Rnd 18: dc2tog 6 times. 6 sts.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

CHEEKS (MAKE TWO)

Using pink, 2 ch.

Rnd 1: 5 dc in 2nd ch from hook. 5 sts.

Fasten off leaving a long thread to sew to head.

EAR (MAKE TWO)

Using white, 2 ch.

Row 1: 4 dc in 2nd ch from hook, turn. 4 sts.

Row 2: 1 ch, 2 dc in each st along. 8 sts.

Fasten off leaving a long thread to sew to head.

BODY

Using white, 6 ch.

Rnd 1: 2dc in second ch from hook, 3 dc, 3 dc in last ch, working in underside of ch, 1 dc in next st,

2 dc, 1 dc in same st as first. 12 sts.

Rnd 2: (2 dc in next st) twice, 3 dc, (2 dc in next

st) 3 times, 3 dc, 2 dc in next st. 18 sts.

Rnd 3: (1 dc, 2 dc in next st) twice, 3 dc, (1 dc, 2 dc in next st) 3 times, 4 dc, 2 dc in next st. 24 sts.

Rnd 4 - 9: 24 dc.

Rnd 10: (1dc, dc2tog) 3 times, 3 dc, (1dc, dc2tog)

3 times, 3dc. 18 sts.

Rnds 11 to 12: 18 dc.

Rnd 13: dc2tog 3 times, 3 dc, dc2tog 3 times,

3dc. 12 sts. Rnd 14: 12dc. Stuff body.

Fasten off leaving a long thread to sew to head.

ARMS AND LEGS (MAKE FOUR)

Using white, 2 ch.

Rnd 1: 8 dc in 2nd ch from hook. 8 sts.

Rnd 2 - 9: 8dc.

Fasten off leaving a long thread to sew to body.

TAIL

Join white with sI st to a st at back of polar bear on rnd 4, 1 ch * yoh, insert hook through same st, yoh, pull through, rep from * 3 more times, till 9 loops on hook, yoh, pull through all 9 loops, 1 ch to close puff st, 1 ch, sI st in same st on rnd 4.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

SCARE

Using blue, 42 ch,

Row 1: 1 htr in 3rd ch from hook, 40 htr. 40 sts.

Row 2: 2 ch, 40 htr.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

FINISHING

Attach eyes to head between rnds 7 and 8, 7 sts apart. Using black, embroider nose. Separate a short length of black into strands and using 2 strands sew a line down under nose. Sew cheeks to head. Curl one side of ear to meet the other and sew ears onto head at rnd 14, 8 sts apart. Sew head onto body. Stuff legs lightly, flatten tops of legs and sew to body in a semi sitting position. Stuff arms lightly, flatten tops of arms and sew to body at a slight angle. Using grey, embroider 3 claws to each hand and foot. Weave two strands of silver lamé through scarf to decorate and tie scarf around polar bear's neck.

SIZE

12.5 cm x 7 cm

TOOLS AND MATERIALS

Ricorumi dk Shade 002 (cream) 25 g Shade 029 (wine red) 25 g 3.5 mm Rico hook Rico stitch markers Rico tapestry needle

TENSION

22 dc and 24 rows = 10 x 10 cm

STOCKING

The stocking is worked beginning with the toe, then the heel, and then up to the top.

Rnd 1: In wine red, 6 dc in a magic ring.

Rnd 2: 2 dc in each st. 12 sts.

Rnd 3: [Dc, 2 dc] 6x around. 18 sts.

Rnd 4: [Dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc] 6x. 24 sts.

Rnd 5: [Dc in next 3 sts, 2 dc] 6x. 30 sts.

Rnds 6-17: Dc in each st around.

Do not fasten off, but leave red yarn attached.

You will pick it back up in round 18.

You will now work the heel of the stocking in turned rows

Rows 1-6: In cream, dc in next 15 sts, ch 1, turn. 15 sts.

Fasten off, and leaving a long tail, break the yarn. Fold the cream portion of the stocking so that the first and last stitch of row 6 match up. Use yarn tail to sew fold together, forming the heel of the stocking. Weave in end.

Rnd 18: Picking up wine red, dc evenly into the ends of the cream rows, with 2 dc in the first row of cream sts, 1 dc in each additional row and in the corner where the rows meet, and 2 dc in the last row of cream sts. Continue to dc in the unworked wine red stitches from round 17. 30 sts. Rnds 19–27: 30 dc.

Rnd 28: In cream, in FLO, dc in each st around. Rnds 29-30: 30 dc.

Ss in the first st of rnd 30. Ch 26, then ss in same first st of the round again. This creates a loop for hanging the stocking. Fasten off, break yarn, and weave in all ends.

ABBREVIATIONS (BRITISH TERMINOLOGY)

ch - chain

dc - double crochet

FLO – front loop only

rnd – round

sl st – slip stitch

st(s) - stitch(es)
