SIZE

Approx 11 cm, 4¼ in

TOOLS AND MATERIAL

Ricorumi dk
Shade 002 (cream) small amount
Shade 009 (coral) 25 g
Shade 060 (black) small amount
Ricorumi Spray dk
Shade 002 (pink) 25 g
Ricorumi crochet hook 3 mm
Rico embroidery needle
Rico synthetic stuffing
Stitch marker

TENSION

20 dc and 20 rnds = 10 x 10 cm

BODY

In pink, working into magic ring, 6 dc. Work in a spiral in continuous rnds.
Rnd 1: [2 dc in next st] 6 times. 12 sts.
Rnd 2: [1 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times. 18 sts.
Rnd 3: [2 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times. 24 sts.
Rnd 4 – 9: 24 dc.
Start filling with stuffing and cont as you go along.
Rnd 10: [2dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 18 sts.
Rnd 11: [1dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 12 sts.
Rnd 12: 12 dc.
Fasten off and break yarn, leaving a long tail.

HEAD

In pink, working into magic ring, 6 dc. Work in a spiral in continuous rnds.
Rnd 1: [2 dc in next st] 6 times. 12 sts.
Rnd 2: [1 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times. 18 sts.
Rnd 3: [2 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times. 24 sts.
Rnd 4: [3 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times. 30 sts.
Rnd 5: [4 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times. 36 sts.
Rnd 6 – 11: 36 dc.
Rnd 12: [4 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 30 sts.
Rnd 13: [3 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 24 sts.
Start filling with stuffing and cont as you go along.
Rnd 14: [2 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 18 sts.
Rnd 15: [1 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 12 sts.
Rnd 16: [dc2tog] 6 times. 6 sts.
Fasten off and break yarn, leaving a long tail.

EAR (MAKE 2)

In pink, working into magic ring, 4 dc. Work in a spiral in continuous rnds.
Rnd 1: [1 dc, 2 dc in next st] 2 times. 6 sts.
Rnd 2: [2 dc, 2 dc in next st] 3 times. 9 sts.
Rnd 3: 9 dc.
Fasten off and break yarn, leaving a long tail.

SNOUT

In coral, make 4 ch, cont working around both sides of chain.
Rnd 1: 1 dc in 2nd ch from hook, 1 dc, 3 dc in next st, cont on the other side of the chain, 1 dc, 3 dc in next st.
Fasten off and break yarn, leaving a long tail.

ARM (MAKE 2)

In pink, working into magic ring, 6 dc. Work in a spiral in continuous rnds.
Do not fill with stuffing.
Rnd 1 – 5: 6 dc.
Fasten off and break yarn.

TO MAKE UP

Join pieces using long end tails. Attach Head to Body. Sew Ears to sides of Head. Sew Arms to Body. Sew Snout to centre of Head. Use black thread to embroider two closed eyes onto face and in cream embroider two small elongated nose holes on Snout.

SIZE

12.5 cm x 7 cm

TOOLS AND MATERIALS

Ricorumi dk
Shade 002 (cream) 25 g
Shade 029 (wine red) 25 g
3.5 mm Rico hook
Rico stitch markers
Rico tapestry needle

TENSION

22 dc and 24 rows = 10 x 10 cm

STOCKING

The stocking is worked beginning with the toe, then the heel, and then up to the top.

Rnd 1: In wine red, 6 dc in a magic ring.

Rnd 2: 2 dc in each st. 12 sts.

Rnd 3: [Dc, 2 dc] 6x around. 18 sts.

Rnd 4: [Dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc] 6x. 24 sts.

Rnd 5: [Dc in next 3 sts, 2 dc] 6x. 30 sts.

Rnds 6–17: Dc in each st around.

Do not fasten off, but leave red yarn attached.

You will pick it back up in round 18.

You will now work the heel of the stocking in turned rows.

Rows 1–6: In cream, dc in next 15 sts, ch 1, turn. 15 sts.

Fasten off, and leaving a long tail, break the yarn. Fold the cream portion of the stocking so that the first and last stitch of row 6 match up. Use yarn tail to sew fold together, forming the heel of the stocking. Weave in end.

Rnd 18: Picking up wine red, dc evenly into the ends of the cream rows, with 2 dc in the first row of cream sts, 1 dc in each additional row and in the corner where the rows meet, and 2 dc in the last row of cream sts. Continue to dc in the unworked wine red stitches from round 17. 30 sts.

Rnds 19–27: 30 dc.

Rnd 28: In cream, in FLO, dc in each st around.

Rnds 29–30: 30 dc.

Ss in the first st of rnd 30. Ch 26, then ss in same first st of the round again. This creates a loop for hanging the stocking. Fasten off, break yarn, and weave in all ends.

ABBREVIATIONS (BRITISH TERMINOLOGY)

ch – chain

dc – double crochet

FLO – front loop only

rnd – round

sl st – slip stitch

st(s) – stitch(es)
